Our logo is based on a twin hulled, ocean going waka. Sailing through the Waitemata Harbour, with Rangitoto in the background. The navigational stars Tautoru (Orions Belt) in the sky.

We have used blue watercolour textures to enhance the connection to the sea and the decoration of pāua.

THE LOGO DESIGN



The inner white area indicates Clear Space.
This area must be kept free of other elements.

Grey padding indicates the Safe Zone; this is an area where other elements can be positioned safely without encroaching on the logos Clear Space; think personal bubble.
